SATS

May is the testing season in schools now. We have done our end of Key Stage 2 Standard Assessment Tests (SATs). We are very proud of all the children in Year 6, who have worked exceptionally hard this year. The children have been put into groups and have been working in rooms around the school with additional teachers to ensure everyone has the right environment to help them achieve their best.

The SATs papers are sent off to be marked and results will be out in early July.

Year 2 children are also completing end of Key Stage 1 tests, to be done this month. The tests are carried out in the children's classrooms with additional adults as needed. Most of the tests are done. These tests are marked internally and the results support the teacher assessment to make a judgement. Parents will know results in July.

Year 1 children will be doing their national phonics screening. Each child is screened individually, by their teacher or a familiar adult, to see how well they know their individual sounds when reading unknown words. These papers are marked by the staff and parents will be informed of the results next term.

A big thank you to you for supporting your children in their learning. It makes a real difference. Team effort!
